## VERDANT FARMS, BEAUTIFUL FAIRWAYS AND EXUBERANT FAMILY FUN

Life in the early days of Wilsonville centered around the main non-rail crossing of the Willamette River, Boones Ferry. Masterminded and operated by Col. Alphonso Boone, grandson of the legendary frontier hero Daniel Boone, the site can still be explored where **Boones Ferry Road** terminates at the historic ferry landing with several historic buildings evident.

A new addition to Wilsonville's landscape is the beautiful **Town Center Park**. The gem at the heart of the park is the **Oregon Korean**

**War Memorial**, a 94-foot long "Wall of Honor" inscribed with the names of the 298 Oregon servicemen killed in that conflict. Three ribbons depicting each major battle line of the war parallel the monument. On a terrace overlooking the peaceful scene, stones dedicated to the fallen punctuate the powerful tableau.

**Clackamas County Regional Visitor Information Center** is conveniently located in the park, with a host of ideas and directions for further exploration in the area, including **Farmers' Markets**.

Downtown Wilsonville is designed for safe, pleasant pedestrian usage...in the neo-traditional style

of other dynamic civic centers developing across America. On the city's outskirts, two meticulously maintained golf courses,

**Charbonneau and Langdon Farms**, are open to the public year-round. Just off I-5, the exuberant attractions of **Wilsonville Family Fun Center** include mini-golf, bumper cars, go-carts, and challenging games in the indoor arcade.

Customers are always welcome to walk through the 12 different theme gardens at the **Barn Owl Nursery**. Barn Owl Nursery is

a home-based business specializing in herbs. Over 400 varieties of locally grown herb plants are available. This includes nearly 80 varieties of lavender and 20 varieties of rosemary.

On the east side of the Interstate, great day-trips by car or bicycle await on the many winding, hilly county roads that meander through picturesque family farms. Just off the I-5

Corridor, Wilsonville typifies the unforgettable Clackamas County landscape: the invigorating feeling of being "out in the country", combined with the convenience of being not far from town.
